1. Negative Coggins dated within one year of the competition is required. Out of state horses must provide an interstate health certificate dated within 30 days of the competition. Proof of flu and rhino vaccinations dated within 6 months of the competition are required.
2. Non-negotiable checks will be charged an additional \$25.
3. Post entries will be accepted if ride times are available. Post entry fee for entries postmarked after the entry close date of August 28, 2018, \$10, if accepted.
4. Refunds - full refund less office fee (\$10) before closing date. After closing date, entry fees and stall fees will be refunded if horse is withdrawn with a veterinarian certification or with a rider medical certification before the first day of the show.
5. Ride times will be posted at [www.ecahs.org](http://www.ecahs.org) prior to the show. Classes may not run in the order listed.
6. Awards - Ribbons 1<sup>st</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> place. Additional awards may be given.
7. Stabling - permanent 12' x 12' stalls with doors are available beginning noon, August 31, 2018. The price for stalls, horse or tack, is \$30. Stalls must be vacated by 10:00pm September 1, 2018. Bedding is available through the grounds. The grounds fee for horses not purchasing stabling is \$10.
8. Horses, with purchased stabling, entered in The Crabbet Celebration do not have to pay for stabling or the grounds fee.
9. Veterinarian - numbers will be posted in the show office.
10. A farrier will not be available.
11. In the event of an emergency, call 911. The Wakefield Fire Department is 6.2 miles away.
12. Sharps disposal - Sharps disposals are available in the barn area.
13. Lodgings and camping sites can be arranged through the facility. Call 757.899.4901 for reservations.

14. Dogs must be on contained or leashed at all times.
15. Footing and rings - Arena: 150' x 300' with sand.
16. The GPS address for directions is 15189 Airfield Rd, Wakefield, VA 23888.

**From the north:** I-95S to Petersburg, VA. US Rt 460E for 25 miles. Turn right onto Main St. Main St becomes Courtland Rd. Turn Right onto Turkey Pen Rd. 1<sup>st</sup> left onto Airfield Rd.

**From the east:** US Rt 460W. Turn left onto Main St. Continue as above.

**From the south:** I-95N to US Rt 58E. Take VA-36 towards Boykins/Courtland. turn left on Meherrin Rd/UA-58 Bus E/VA-35. Turn left on VA-35/Main St. Turn right onto Wakefield Rd. Wakefield Rd becomes Courtland Rd. Continue as above.

**From the west:** US Rt 460 E to US Rt 460 Bus. Turn right onto S Main St/VA-40. Turn left onto Brunswick Rd/VAVA-46. Turn left onto N Main St/US-58 Bus E. Merge unto US-58 E. Take VA-36 toward Boykins/Courtland. Turn left onto VA-35/Main St. Turn right onto Wakefield Rd. Continue as above.

### **Motorized Vehicle Statement**

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

I have read the United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") Entry Agreement (GR906.4) as printed in the Prize List for this Competition and agree to all of its provisions. I understand and agree that by entering this Competition, I am subject to Federation Rules, the Prize List, and local rules of the competition. I agree to waive the right to the use of my photos at the competition, and agree that any actions against the Federation must be brought in New York State.

**Release, Assumption of Risk, Waiver and Indemnification**

**This document waives important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.**

I **AGREE** in consideration for my participation in this Competition to the following:

I **AGREE** that the "Federation" and "Competition" as used above includes all of their officials, officers, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers and affiliated organizations.

I **AGREE** that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Competition with my horse, as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, or as parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the Competition involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death ("Harm").

I **AGREE** to hold harmless and release the Federation and the Competition from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm of any nature caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm arises or results, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of the Federation or the Competition.

I **AGREE** to expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my horse, including Harm resulting from the negligence of the Federation or the Competition.

I **AGREE** to indemnify (that is, to pay any losses, damages, or costs incurred by) the Federation and the Competition and to hold them harmless with respect to claims for Harm to me or my horse, and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me or my horse while at the Competition.

I have read the Federation Rules about protective equipment, including GR801 and, if applicable, EV114 and I understand that I am entitled to wear protective equipment without penalty, and I acknowledge that the Federation strongly encourages me to do so while WARNING that no protective equipment can guard against all injuries.

If I am a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation and AGREE to all of the above provisions and AGREE to assume all of the obligations of this Release on the child's behalf.
