Judy Kibler

I have been associated with Arabian horses since 1960 - training, breeding, instructing, marketing and judging.

My first introduction to the world of Crabbet Arabian bred horses was growing up in Southern California and the Kellogg Ranch. My first Arabian was the handsome Jerab (Jedriss X Rabika). He stood at Kellogg's as a remount breeding stallion! Later in his life he was my show horse and best friend. My early high school graduation present

was the filly Miss Floco (Abu Farwa X Rose of Damascus). As a show and breeding mare she was what I dreamed about as the true Crabbet horse.



I have been a Licensed Equine Judge since 1971 holding licenses with USEF in multiple divisions. My judging assignments have included multiple International and National Championship Shows, Canadian Nationals, Youth Nationals and many Regional shows within the Arabian and Morgan Horse breed.

I sit on the AHA Judges and Stewards Steering Committee and have participated on the AHA Equitation Committee, the AHA Equine Stress Committee, the AHA Working Western Committee and the AHA Professional

Horseman's Committee for the past 40 years as an active committee member. I also sit on the USEF Western Committee.

Most recently along with my late husband, Chuck, we spent 10 years managing the historic El Rancho Escondido Ranch on Catalina Island, then back to Arizona where I was at Al-Marah Arabians in Tucson, AZ working to help finalize the last year of operation at the farm. I was also on staff at Al-Marah as the marketing director, oversaw the lesson program and did the advertising. All under the guidance of Mrs. Tankersley.

In 2015, I was inducted into the AHA Judges' Hall of Fame.

Then in 2017, I was on the judging panel for the UKIAHS (United Kingdom International Arabian Horse Show) in Winslow, UK.

Recently I was part of the 50th Queensland Arabian Challenge Show and the All Arabian Horse Show in Victoria, NSW, Australia.

For 60 years I have had the privilege of participating in the wonderful world of Arabian Horses and am grateful to the ECAHS for this honor of the Benefactor of the Breed award.

Chuck Kibler

Chuck Kibler was a lifelong horseman. He was born in Troy, Kansas and grew up in Colorado Springs, Colorado.

Chuck trained horses for over 50 years before his passing in 2004.

After a six year professional rodeo career, Chuck chose to make his future with Arabian horses. He was particularly known for his Western Pleasure and Reining horses. During the 1970's and 80's, AHA (then IAHA) had a national show devoted to the young Arabian horses (IAHA Snaffle Bit Futurity Show). Chuck trained and rode 29 Champions and 14 Reserve Champions during that time — an amazing accomplishment!

His Arabian National Show credits include 20+ National and Reserve Champions. Chuck was an Equine Science Instructor at Scottsdale

Community College. Many of our horsemen and women today are students he guided through their equine learning experience.

He was equally respected as an Equine Judge approved by IAHA/AHA and USEF.

Chuck was inducted into the AHA Judges Hall of Fame in 2006.

Also, respected as a breeder of Arabian horses, one of the first brood mares the family had in Colorado was a Silfix daughter out of a Handeyraff daughter. He was the breeder of 20+ foals that were based on the Crabbet lines. He chose these bloodlines because of their athletic ability and tractability!

Chuck was head trainer at Al-Marah Arabians in Tucson, AZ when he passed.

Chuck was always respected as a true horseman





Greeting from Skatrud Arabians

2023 was a terrific year for Skatrud Arabians. Under the professional training of Bobbi Eisenberg, Our Farm of Somonauk, Illinois, our Dressage/Sport Horses accomplished many successes in the show ring, including Region 11, Region 10, National Dressage Pony Cup, East Coast Championships and Sport Horse Nationals. A special thank you to Molly Schwister who showed our horses so beautifully in Amateur classes.

Skats Magnum Star, aka Sprite, competed in 3rd level and progressed to 4th level dressage. He won many Championships during the year and was named National Reserve Champion in 3rd level and Top 10 in 4th level (4th of 18) at Sport Horse Nationals. The audience enjoyed watching Sprite and Bobbi perform Free Style where they were Champions at the National Dressage Pony Cup, winning the Deb M'Congonnel Free Stlye Award and Top 10 at SHN. At the National Dressage Pony Cup, Sprite won the Championship in both 3rd & 4th levels. He also won the Power Play Award, highest single score of an Arabian Pony , for the 4th time.

Skats Star Sensation, aka Sparky, Sprite's oldest son, made his debut in dressage and sport horse. Like his sire, Sparky is very athletic and has a heart of gold. Sparky won Championships in traditional dressage, western dressage and sport horse under saddle. At the National Dressage Pony Cup, Sparky was the Champion High Point Arabian and 6th Overall in the Small Horse Training Level. He earned Top 10 at SHN in Arab Western Dressage Basic ATR and Arab Western Dressage Level 1 Open. He was named winner of the High Point Western Dressage Jr. Horse. This young gelding has just begun his path to stardom.

Our gelding Skats Kash Investment (Khash PGA x Skats Reddd Courage) also had a very successful competition year. He too, won several Championships in Sport Horse Under Saddle, 1st level and 2nd level. At SHN he was Reserve Champion Arab 2nd level ATR and Reserve Champion in Arab SHIH Geldings Hunter type 3 & Over ATH. He won Top 10 in Arab SHIH Geldings Hunter, 3 & Over Open, Arab Show Hack Open, Arab Dressage 1st level Open and ATR, Arab Dressage 2nd level Open and Arab SHIH Geldings Dressage type 3 & Over ATH.

At home, we are raising a beautiful filly by Malik El Jamaal x Skats Star Airebella. She will have a full sibling in 2024. This filly is Breeders Sweepstakes, Region 12Spotlight Futurity and Scottsdale Signature Stallion Futurity nominated. Contact us for pricing.
