



Last year I had lumbar fusion surgery. That went pretty well - resolved the sciatica and I could stand up straight!!.

However, now I am scheduled for cervical fusion surgery on March 24th. Following my back surgery, I developed rheumatoid arthritis, affecting mainly my hands. My handwriting and my grip strength is pathetic. For example, grooming the horses is not possible. I can't lift anything heavy (i.e. hay bales or feed sack).

David is doing the "heavy lifting" (LOL) for me, but his health is not robust.

The bottom line is the boys need to find a new home ASAP.

A rescue group is my last resort - but it would be nice if someone appreciated them and gave them a job. If not ECAHS, possibly 4H. I really don't have any contacts any more. If not, the rescue should be able to find them good homes.

I'm continuing to ride my wonderful FCF King of the Fairys (AAA Legend of the Seas x FCF Titanias Vanity) and am enjoying twice a week dressage lessons. I've been going to physical therapy for a loss of mobility and pain in my right hip, and I'm regaining a lot of mobility and strength. The physical therapist is a rider from the same barn where I board King, but her horse passed away a few years ago. She's recovering from a torn muscle so was seeking a reliable horse to help her regain her riding fitness. I offered to let her ride King twice a week. She ADORES him! While she is impressed with his athleticism and structure, what really won her over is his calm, confident, and friendly personality. She recognizes that his temperament is a combination of good breeding and being raised well. It's really wonderful to be able to share these horses with other people and expose them to the qualities of Crabbet lineage Arabians!

We are looking forward to the foal by VG Juan Inamillion+ and out of FCF As You Wish that is due in May. For 2025, we are hoping to breed FCF Titanias Vanity back to FV Kissme Rabba. The 2024 filly from that cross is outstanding, and we'd like another. Titania has been a fabulous producer for us and we'd like to get one more foal from her. We are also planning to breed FCF Winged Valkyrie this year, though we are still finalizing the stallion selection.

Since we will be scaling back on breeding in the coming years, we have reluctantly decided to geld our young stallion prospect, FCF Titans Silver Aura (Aur Elijah x FCF Titanias Vanity). He's still a wonderful stallion prospect out of a stellar mare line, but he's closely related to the young mares we are retaining and now that Obie is retired at home, we don't have sufficient turnout facilities to manage two stallions here long term. Titan will make a wonderful gelding and an excellent performance horse for someone. The breeding numbers for purebreds is also so incredibly low –and still dropping every year—so there is less demand for stallions no matter their quality. He has a lovely older (half) brother by Aur Elijah already breeding on the west coast so the sire line will continue to be represented.

We are really excited about how our 2024 filly, FCF Fairy Queens Kiss is maturing. At 9 months old she is quite tall at around 14 H already! In spite of her current lanky state, she is still very athletic and balanced in her structure. She is also quite beautiful and has the steady calm intelligent temperament of her dam and all her dam's other offspring. Her sire contributed many of the same strengths possessed by her dam and is also partly responsible for the height! Titania is just shy of 14.3H, but her dam (AM Tawny Britania by *Sa'Ika x AM Dream of Dawn) was 15.3H so there may have been some height genetics lurking there too!
